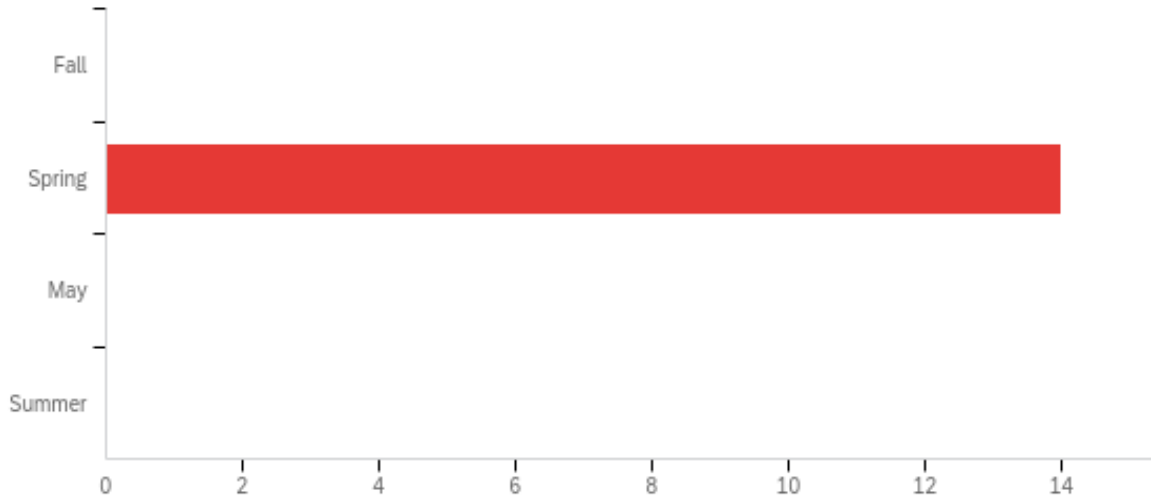

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I actually learned a lot from this course and it constantly held my interest and made me really think about things differently.

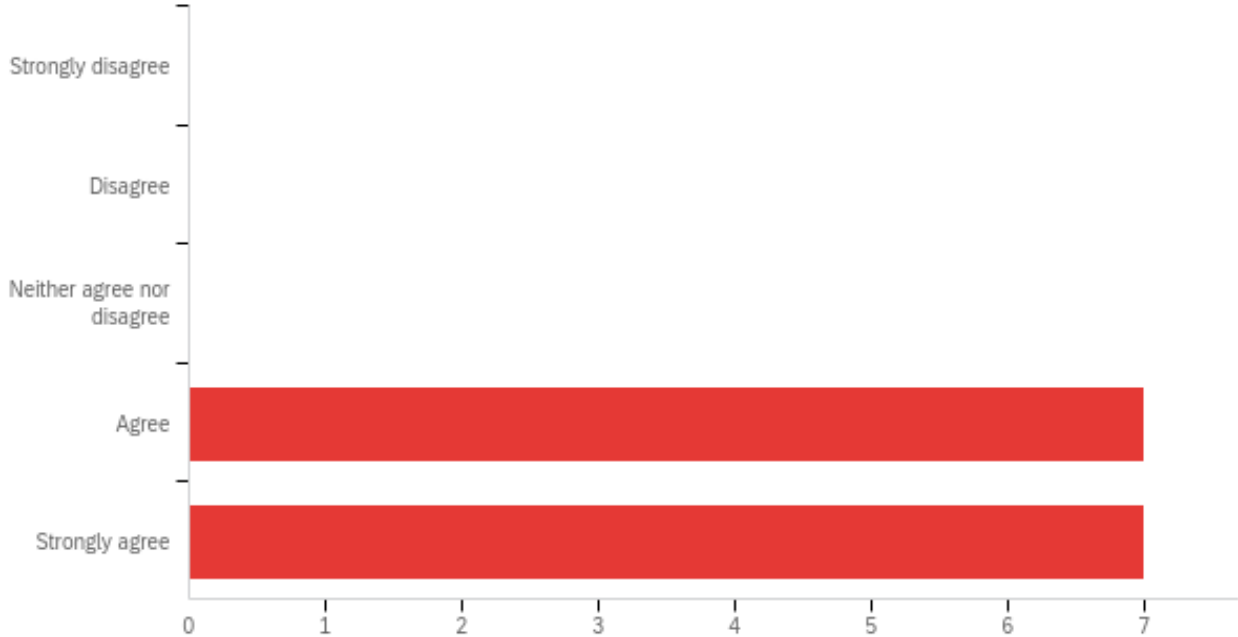
